

# **Free Pit bull Spay/Neuter Program**

**Surgery dates are given out on a first come, first serve basis.**

**Surgeries are done on Wednesdays and Thursdays.**

**You must have your pet at the shelter between 4:30 and 5:00pm on your surgery date.  
The pet will stay the night and can be picked up between 8:00 and 8:30 am the following morning.**

## **Qualifications:**

- **You must be a resident of Peoria County**
- **Your dog must be vaccinated for rabies and registered in your name**
- **You must provide a driver's license or ID card that shows your Peoria County address**

# **Low Cost Spay-Neuter Clinic**

**Clinics are held about once a month and cost \$68.**

**The clinic includes the spay/neuter and a rabies shot and county tag.**

**Spots in the clinic are given on a first come, first serve basis.**

## **Qualifications:**

- **Income guidelines are as follows: 1 person family - less than \$17,500; 2 person family - less than \$12,500; 3 person family - \$27,000; 4 person family - \$30,000; 5 person family - \$35,500; 6 person family - \$38,000; 7 person family - \$43,000, and 8+ family - \$45,000**
- **You need to bring your 1040 tax forms or a social security benefits letter to the shelter as proof of income**
- **You must pay \$68 in cash and present an ID at the time of sign up**
